

Policy Title: ABSN Admission Deferral Policy

Policy Purpose: To delineate how the deferral process will be managed related to admission

into MNU's ABSN program. Students who are offered a conditional

acceptance for a specific cohort are with increased frequency requesting to

defer admission to the next and/or subsequent cohorts.

Policy Statement: The ABSN Committee provides oversight to the admission process for each

ABSN cohort.

- Students who ask to have their admission start date deferred to another cohort must provide the request in writing (email message is fine), to the ABSN Admission committee.
- 2. Students will only be considered for the next cohort and not subsequent cohorts.
- 3. The ABSN Admission Committee will review those requests.
- 4. A guaranteed deferral will be granted if the student meets the following criteria:
 - i. A combined GPA score of 6.4 (Pre-req and Cum) OR Pre-req GPA ≥ 3.4
 - ii. Pre-req courses may only be repeated one time; no more than 2 pre-req courses may be repeated
 - iii. TEAS score ≥72% (may only be taken twice)
 - iv. TOEFL score > 80
- 5. If the deferral is granted, a non-refundable deposit must be submitted within 30 days.
- 6. A deferral will only be granted one time and cannot be extended beyond the specified cohort.
- 7. Students who do not meet the above criteria may reapply in NursingCAS.
 - If the application is less than one year old and there has not been a NursingCAS
 platform change, the reapplication process will not be required (due to NursingCAS
 fees and need for repeat transcript submission).
