



Number of graduates for all ACBSP accredited programs, 2020-21:





Employment/Job preparedness data for all ACBSP accredited programs, 2020-21:

Traditional Undergraduate Programs

Of those students who completed the 2021 traditional undergraduate senior exit survey:

- 90% agreed/strongly agreed that MNU's business program prepared them with the knowledge and skills to enter a career in business and/or pursue graduate school or professional certification.
- 43% had a full-time job or job offer in the field of business, prior to graduation.
- 5% were already enrolled in graduate school, prior to graduation.

Of those students who completed the 2021 traditional undergraduate one-year alumni survey:

- **67%** agreed/strongly agreed that their academic experiences in the MNU business department prepared them for the next steps in their professional future.
- **60%** are currently employed in a business-related field. (100% of those students were offered the job within 6 months of graduating.)
- **20%** are currently enrolled in graduate school.

Organizational Leadership (OL) Program

Of those students who completed the 2021 OL exit survey:

• **92%** agreed/strongly agreed that MNU's OL program had adequately prepared them to enter, or advance, in my chosen career and/or graduate studies.

Of those students who completed the 2021 OL one-year alumni survey:

• 94% agreed/strongly agreed that the academic experiences in MNU's business program prepared them to manage their career and increased their confidence in pursuing the next steps in their professional future.

Online Bachelor of Business Administration (OBBA) Program

Of those students who completed the 2021 OBBA exit survey:

• 77% agreed/strongly agreed that MNU's OBBA program had adequately prepared them to enter, or advance, in my chosen career and/or graduate studies.

Of those students who completed the 2021 MSM exit survey:



• **78**% agreed/strongly agreed that MNU's graduate business program prepared them for or advanced their career.


Outbound external exam results for all ACBSP accredited programs, 2020-21:

Traditional Undergraduate Programs





Organizational Leadership (OL) Program





Online Bachelor of Business Administration Program (OBBA)




